CHC43115 Certificate IV in Disability

Disability workers work in a range of disability support contexts including residential group homes, training resource centres, day respite centres and open employment services, other community settings and clients' homes.

These workers:

- Apply knowledge and skills gained through qualifications and/or previous experience to provide training and support to people with disabilities to enhance their ability to achieve greater levels of independence, self reliance and community participation
- Report to service managers and may liaise with health professionals and other service agencies
- May work without direct supervision and may be required to supervise and/or coordinate a limited number of lower classified workers.

Job roles for this qualification are:

- Behavioural support officer
- Development officer
- Disability officer – day support
- Disability support officer / worker
- Project officer (life enhancement team)
- Residential care officer
- Senior personal care assistant
- Social educator

For students who have completed their CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support at The Centre or elsewhere*, you can get up to 7 Credit Transfers (that's 50% of the course) out of the CHC43115 Certificate IV in Disability

Become a Teachers Aide

Teachers' aides work in a range of classroom contexts, including public and independent schools and community education settings.

Teachers' aides provide assistance and support under broad-based supervision to teachers and students. Structured Workplace Learning is also undertaken during this course to provide the on-the-job experience that will give you the skills that will help you to secure employment.

You will learn how to support students with literacy and numeracy, put into practice support behaviour strategies, and apply the principles of inclusion and diversity.

Learners must have a current Working with Children Card prior to commencing Work Placement.

CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support

Work in Aged Care or Home and Community Care

Our successful partnership with local aged care facilities has seen learners study CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing, Home and Community Care) on site and then train in the facility the very next day putting everything learnt into practice.

The strength of this program is reinforced when students complete the qualification as their workplace training has been tailored to each facilities requirements, making them ideal candidates for work. Learners are already familiar with how the facility runs, the policies and procedures, and the residents. They are also trained specifically to the facility's standards.

Learners must have a current National Police Check and completed their immunisation prior to commencing Work Placement in a facility.
