

# **Prohibited items**

# **Purpose and Scope**

The Centre acknowledges that the safety of its staff and learners is of key importance. This policy is to ensure that The Centre Staff and learners have a safe working environment free from prohibited items.

# **Policy**

## 1 The Centre's commitment

- 1.1 The Centre is committed to
  - 1.1.1 Zero tolerance to prohibited items
  - 1.1.2 Maintaining a safe environment for staff and learners
  - 1.1.3 Maintaining its responsibility under the law to report incidents relating to prohibited items to the police in a timely manner
  - 1.1.4 Meeting the responsibility under the requirements of The Centre's Child Safe Policy

# 2 Illegal substances and drug use

- 2.1 Any staff or learner who attends The Centre affected by, under the influence or in possession of an;
  - 2.1.1 Illegal substances
  - 2.1.2 will be asked to leave the premises immediately.
  - 2.1.3 May be reported to the police if found in the possession of an illegal substance
  - 2.1.4 Breaches of the policy may be subject to disciplinary action (refer to section 6)

# 3 Prescription or over the counter medication

- 3.1 It is the responsibility of staff or learner to
  - 3.1.1 be aware of any prescription or over the counter medication side effects to ensure that the side effects do not interfere with their ability to behave safely.
- 3.2 Will be asked to leave the premises or activity immediately if they are unduly affected by the prescribed drugs

### 4 Weapons

- 4.1 The Centre has a zero tolerance regarding weapons.
- 4.2 Weapons of any kind are not to be carried by staff or learners.
- 4.3 Where it is suspected that staff or clients are carrying a weapon
  - 4.3.1 Call police on 000

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- 4.3.2 Inform Centre management
- 4.3.3 Initiate a lockdown

# 5 Smoking, and Vaping

- 5.1 The Centre is a smoke-free workplace in and around buildings and common areas
- 5.2 There is a designated smoking area adjacent to The Centre. All staff and learners who smoke or vape must use this designated area to smoke.
- 5.3 Inhaling industrial products is not permitted

# 6 Consequences of breaching this policy

6.1 Staff, clients or learners found to have breached this policy may be subjected to disciplinary action according to The Centre Policies and procedures.

# **Definitions**

# **Illegal Substances**

Any drug which is illegal to possess or use or any legal drug used in an illegal manner.

### Weapon

As defined by the Control of Weapons Act 1990

#### Learner/ Client

Any person engaged in programs or activities conducted by or at The Centre

#### Staff

For the purpose of this policy staff refers to permanent, full-time or part-time employees, casual staff, volunteers and tutors. Contractors are also included

#### Prohibited item

As defined by the Crimes Act 1958 (Vic)

### **Industrial products**

For the purposes of this policy, industrial products include items such as:

- Paints
- Glues
- Chemicals
- Petrol
